The Malta Tourism Authority Hosts Pierluigi Collina on Valletta Tour

World renowned former football referee and personality Pierluigi Collina was hosted on a walking tour of Valletta organised by the Malta Tourism Authority. The former International FIFA referee and current member of the UEFA referees committee, was the keynote speaker at a prestigious event held at one of the leading hotels later in the day.

Mr. Collina was greeted at the Upper Barrakka Gardens by MTA Chairman, Dr. Gavin Gulia who welcomed the celebrity referee to Malta's historic capital.
