OVER 100 INTERNATIONAL WINES AT THE COSPICUA WATERFRONT

The Malta International Wine Festival is Malta's first exclusive international wine festival. The festival focuses on showcasing wines from Malta and around the world.

Whether you're a seasoned expert or an intrigued beginner, winemakers and winery representatives welcome you as they pair their useful knowledge with exquisite samples of their art. Visitors are able to buy wine by the glass or by the bottle from over 100 international wines available at the wine experiences set by Cospicua's waterfront.

Learn about the art of wine making, sample some of the best wines, meet notable wine makers and enjoy gastronomy and live music all in a breathtaking setting at Dock 1, Cospicua.

For either the experienced wine lover or the novice, the festival has something to please every palate and pocketbook, with incessant engagements and an exciting experience.

The festival includes an on-site liquor store that allows consumers to buy wines at the festival, which tickle their taste buds. Short talks by professional sommeliers will take place in a designated area delivering the knowledge of wines.

The first edition of the Malta International Wine Festival will be held at Dock 1, Cospicua between the 28th and the 30th June 2019 from 18:00 onwards.

The Malta Public Transport Service will be operating on special routes while the Valletta Ferry will travel continuously from Valletta to Bormla. Medasia Cabs will be offering discounts for those who travel to and from the event on each night.

The Malta Tourism Authority's Executive Chairman, Gavin Gulia, welcomed the introduction of a new event, particularly one which is to be set in the lavish surroundings of Cospicua, as with one event the Maltese Islands would be able to promote its high level of wine production as well as a stunning part of the Islands. Dr Gulia thanked everyone involved for doing their utmost to ensure that the event goes smoothly.

The Minister for Tourism, Konrad Mizzi, emphasized on the recognition which is being given to the Cottonera area with regards to high quality events. The International Wine Festival is an event which is taking place for the first time and it is expected to attract both locals and tourists to the beautiful city of Cospicua. This is another free event for all to enjoy which we are supporting, while we would

like to thank the Institute for Tourism Studies, as thanks to their expertise, we are going to teach guests through gastronomy related sessions. I look forward to more free events for everyone to enjoy.

II-Festival Malti tal-Inbid Internazzjonali huwa l-ewwel festival tax-xorta tiegħu f'pajjiżna. Dan l-avveniment ser jesponi u jservi ta' pjattaforma għall-inbid Malti u inbid ieħor minn madwar id-dinja.

Kemm jekk int espert, dilettant tal-inbid jew tinteressak ħarġa b'differenza, għadd ta' importaturi u produkturi tal-inbid ser ikunu qiegħdin joffru selezzjoni wiesa ta' inbid matul dan l-avveniment. 8 esperjenzi differenti, minn 5 kontinenti, b'aktar minn 100 flixkun inbid ikkumplimentanti b'ikel Malti, Meditarranju u ikel ieħor minn madwar id-dinja.

Sħarrerġ u informa ruħek fuq il-kultura tal-inbid, aghażel minn uħud fost l-aqwa inbejjed fid-dinja u gawdi lejla maġika ta' divertiment kontienwu f'dan l-ewwel avveniment fuq skala Nazzjonali fil-qalba ta' Bormla.

L-avveniment ser ikun kompost minn għadd ta' esebizzjonijiet fejn wieħed jista' jixtri tazza tal-inbid għall-prezz ta' 2 Ewro u jagħżel li jduq l-inbid l-aktar favorit tiegħu. Id-dħul għal dan l-avveniment ser ikun b'xejn.
