COVID-19: MTA INSPECTS OUTLETS

During Tuesday 24th March 2020, the Malta Tourism Authority proceeded to carry out inspections of catering establishments and other premises across Malta and Gozo.

In Malta, more than 800 additional inspections were carried out in 40 different localities across the island.

This latest series of inspections brings the total number of verifications that have been carried out since the Legal Notice came into force to more than 4650 in Malta alone.

In addition, MTA's inspectors in Gozo checked another 150 establishments in different towns and villages all over the sister island.

Once again, MTA is pleased to note that no establishments in Malta and Gozo were found to be in breach of the regulations.

Meanwhile, the Authority would like to, once again, remind the general public of the importance to avoid queuing up in large numbers outside take-away establishments, and to keep a safe distance away from others at all times. The few that are disregarding this advice may harm the efforts and sacrifices being made by the vast majority of the population in order to stem the spread of Covid-19.
