COVID-19: MTA INSPECTS OUTLETS

Throughout Thursday 26th March 2020, the Malta Tourism Authority continued with its ongoing series of inspections of catering establishments and other premises around Malta and Gozo.

In the 24 hour period since the last update, well over a thousand bars, snack-bars, restaurants and other premises were checked. In Malta, more than 930 inspections were carried out in 26 different localities. Of these, more than one third (350) took place in the Sliema/St Julian's area including Gzira, Msida and Ta' Xbiex.

In addition, MTA's inspectors in Gozo checked another 150 establishments in different towns and villages all over the sister island.

Once again, no breaches were found, neither in Gozo, nor in Malta.

Since the relevant Legal Notices came into force, the Malta Tourism Authority carried out more than 7500 inspections of catering establishments and other premises. Over 6100 inspections took place in Malta and more than 1450 in Gozo.
