COVID-19: MTA INSPECTS OUTLETS

Throughout Tuesday 31st March 2020, MTA continued with its programme of inspections of restaurants, bars, snack bars and other outlets.

In Malta, more than 745 inspections were carried out in 21 different localities across the island. Of these, more than fifty percent (420) took place in the Sliema/St Julian's area.

In Gozo, MTA's inspectors checked around 170 establishments in the following towns and villages: Dwejra, Għajnsielem, Marsalforn, Mġarr Harbour, Munxar, Qbajjar, Sannat, Victoria, Xagħra, Xewkija, Xlendi, Xwejni and Żewwieqa area.

Once again no breaches were found, neither in Gozo nor in Malta.

With these latest inspections, the total number of inspections that the Malta Tourism Authority has carried out since the relevant Legal Notices came into force rose to more than 11,060 inspections. More than 8820 inspections took place in Malta and over 2240 in Gozo.
