COVID-19: MTA INSPECTS OUTLETS

With the start of a new month, the Malta Tourism Authority continued with its inspections of bars, snack-bars, restaurants and other catering establishments to ensure compliance with the Covid-19 regulations.

During Wednesday 01st April 2020, more than 720 inspections were carried out in 27 different localities in Malta. Of these, more than 140 inspections took place in Valletta/Floriana and more than 100 establishments were checked in Marsaskala/Marsaxlokk.

In Gozo, MTA checked around 160 establishments located in 11 towns and villages, namely: Ħondoq, Marsalforn, Mgarr, Munxar, Nadur, Qala, Qbajjar, Victoria, Xewkija, Xlendi and Xwejni.

Once again, no breaches were found, neither in Gozo, nor in Malta. Establishments were found to be closed or operating strictly on a take-away basis.

Since the relevant Legal Notices came into force, the number of inspections around Malta and Gozo has surpassed 11,940 inspections. More than 9540 inspections took place in Malta and over 2400 in Gozo.
