COVID-19: MTA INSPECTS OUTLETS

During Friday 03rd April 2020, the Malta Tourism Authority continued with its inspections of catering establishments including bars, snack-bars, restaurants and others to ensure that they are fully compliant with the Covid-19 regulations.

In Malta, more than 1045 inspections were carried out in 27 different localities during the 24 hours since the last report. Of these, more than 225 inspections took place in the Sliema/Gzira/St Julian's area and more than 125 establishments were checked in the Marsaskala/Marsaxlokk/Zejtun area.

In Gozo, MTA checked around 160 establishments located in 13 towns and villages.

Once again, no breaches were found, neither in Gozo, nor in Malta.

Since the relevant Legal Notices came into force, the number of inspections around Malta and Gozo has surpassed 14,100 inspections. More than 11,380 inspections have taken place in Malta and over 2720 were carried out in Gozo.
