## **COVID-19: MTA INSPECTS OUTLETS**

## ISSUED 11/04/2020

Throughout Friday 10th April 2020, MTA continued with its inspections of restaurants, bars, snack-bars and other catering establishments aimed at ensuring compliance with the Covid-19 regulations.

During the 24-hours since the last report, more than 770 inspections were carried out.

In Malta, around 600 inspections were conducted in 15 different localities. Of these, about 440 inspections took place in the Sliema/Gzira/St Julian's area.

In Gozo, MTA checked more than 170 establishments located in 20 towns and villages.

During this latest batch of inspections, no breaches were found, neither in Malta nor in Gozo.

Since the relevant Legal Notices came into force, the total number of inspections around Malta and Gozo has surpassed 21,120 inspections. More than 17,190 inspections have taken place in Malta and over 3,930 were carried out in Gozo.

MTA reminds the general public on the need to practice social distancing and to remain as much as possible at home.
